"SUCH LONG LEGS!" wrote New York businessman Benjamin F. Seaver. "They stick up in the air, as he sits in an ordinary chair." This multiple-lens photograph by Anthony Berger of Brady's Gallery, White House Cabinet Room, Washington, D. C., Tuesday, April 26, 1864, shows Lincoln's legs wider apart. The crossed legs in the light trousers are those of John G. Nicolay; the leg at the left is Carpenter's.
