ONLY TWO PHOTOGRAPHS were signed by Lincoln with this unusual inscription. Both were presented to Gustave E. Matile, undersecretary to John Hay. Three months after Lincoln's death, Matile presented the handsome example (opposite) to his friend, Charles M. Gormly, whose grandson, Stephen G. Schwartz, provided the copy negative for reproduction in this volume. The second photograph (above, left), identical except for the ruled oval border, was given by Matile to the Kellogg Public Library in Green Bay, Wisconsin. An exact copy of a signed photograph of the pose (above, right) is in the Lincoln National Life Foundation.
