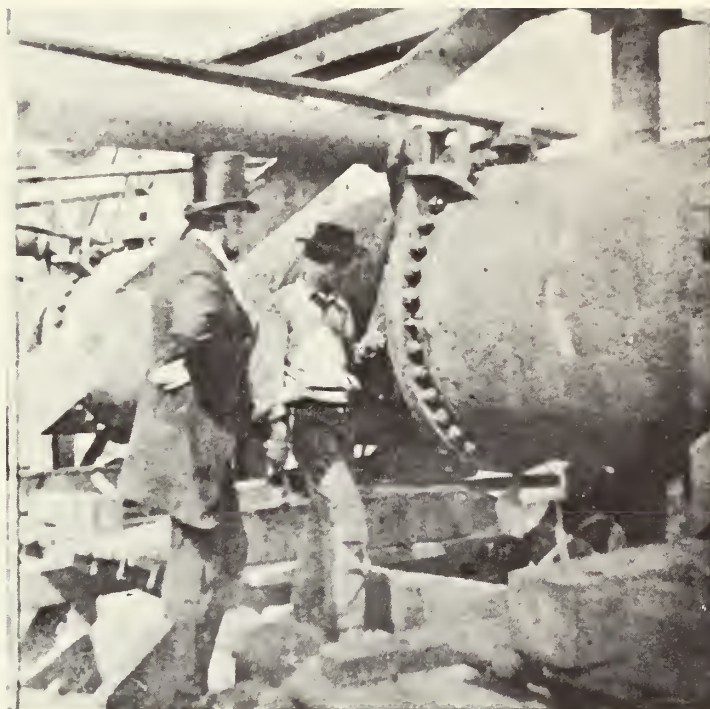


FIRST PUBLISHED by Frederick Hill Meserve as a questionable photograph of Lincoln in his *Supplement Number Four*, privately printed in New York, 1955. Meserve gave it a "B" designation instead of a number.

THE TALL FIGURE bears a great resemblance to Lincoln. Identified as "A. Lincoln" in pencil on the front of the original stereograph, of which only one half is shown here, the man in the stovepipe hat could easily be another person. Originally owned by Charles F. Thomas, who supervised the building of the Capitol dome in 1861, this rare view is now in the collection of the Lincoln National Life Foundation.
