It was recorded that Warren "made three pictures of Mr. Lincoln, one standing, and two sitting." The two seated poses (O-112 and O-113) were made on a chair which Lincoln himself carried out on the balcony, but the standing pose has never come to light.

After Warren's death, according to friends, his collection of negatives changed hands several times. Its present location is not known.
